



Online Missionary Debriefing Information

Ideally, missionary debriefing is done in person. However, we realize that for some, the ideal is not possible. Therefore, we also make online debriefing available to individuals and couples.

Theme: The theme of debriefing is Romans 8:28.

Dates: Scheduled at the convenience of the Luppinos and participants.

Program: M.E.N.D. consists of seven facilitated modules focusing on a missionary's most recent term on the field. There are homework assignments that revolve around a timeline done by the missionaries being debriefed.

Cost: There is no charge to provide debriefing to missionaries.

Additional Considerations:

1. When debriefing a couple, we ask that each be on a different computer if possible. Research and experience show that if a computer is shared, the time will be dominated by one of the participants.
2. We will not violate the confidentiality of those whom we debrief.
3. We schedule the sessions at the convenience of the missionaries being debriefed.
4. We ask that missionaries with children arrange child care during the debriefing sessions or schedule at a time when the children will not be a distraction.
5. The doctrinal statement of Chris and Nancy Luppino is available on request. Our doctrine would reflect that of independent Baptists. However, the purpose of M.E.N.D. is not to debate or discuss doctrine.
6. The goal of M.E.N.D. is to help missionaries develop resilience and to serve as long on the field as the Lord desires them to do so.
